Upperton is a peaceful rural hamlet three miles west of Watlington. With neighbouring Brightwell Baldwin, it features a 15th-century church and the popular Lord Nelson Inn. Watlington offers shops, schools, library, medical practice and sports facilities, while Benson, Wallingford, Thame and Henley provide amenities and M40 access for commuters nearby.



THE PROPERTY

Set within about 1.5 acres of attractive grounds, The Pines is a charming 17th-century home, originally the local dairy and later Upperton Farmhouse, with elegant 19th-century additions. Owned by the same family for nearly 40 years, it offers flexible accommodation with far-reaching rural views.

An elevated porch leads to an entrance hall, a bright double-aspect sitting room and a second reception room. The first floor has the principal suite, two bedrooms and bathroom, while the top floor adds two bedrooms and a shower room. The lower ground floor includes the kitchen, dining room, study, utility space, cellar, games room, wine store and storage.
