# Beers

Peoples Park Road, Crediton

- Attractive 1930s semi-detached house

Set on the ever popular Peoples Park Road, just a short walk from Crediton's High Street, Beers is a particularly attractive 1930s semi-detached home that combines the character and proportions of its era with thoughtful modern improvements. From its slightly elevated position the house enjoys pleasant south facing views across the town, while the location means shops, cafés, schools and transport links are all within a few minutes' walk. It's one of those spots in Crediton that rarely loses its appeal plus of course, the open green space of Peoples Park is just moments away.



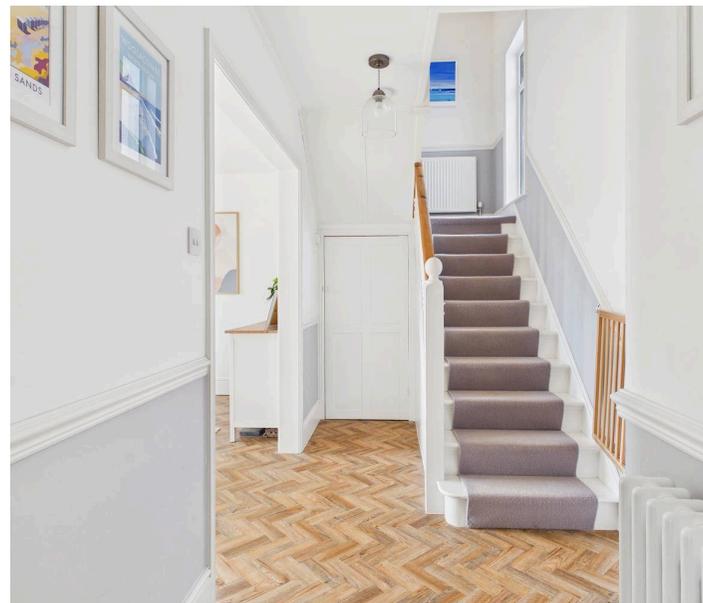


Inside, the house has the space and balance typical of the period, with a bay windowed reception room creating a bright and welcoming living area to the front of the property plus an additional adjacent reception room too. These rooms offer flexibility depending on how you like to live, whether as a traditional living and dining room arrangement or with one used as a more relaxed family space. To the rear, the kitchen/breakfast room forms the natural hub of the home, providing a practical and sociable space for everyday life. There's lots of storage, plus a useful breakfast bar gives flexibility to the overall layout and a separate utility room (with door to outside) keeps laundry neatly out of the way. To complete the ground floor is a stylish, modern shower room and WC – perfect for family life.

Upstairs there are four bedrooms and the family bathroom, offering a layout that works comfortably for family living, guests or working from home. The rooms feel light and well proportioned, and the elevated setting allows glimpses across the town from several windows and out to the surrounding rolling countryside.

Outside, the gardens have recently been thoughtfully improved. The rear garden has been redesigned to create an attractive and usable outdoor space with lawn, seating areas and planted beds, giving somewhere to relax, entertain or simply enjoy the surroundings. To the front there are established gardens along with driveway parking and a garage.

Quality homes within the town are consistently sought after, particularly those that retain their original character while being carefully updated for modern living. Beers is a particularly good example, offering space, style and a location that allows you to enjoy the best of Crediton within easy walking distance.

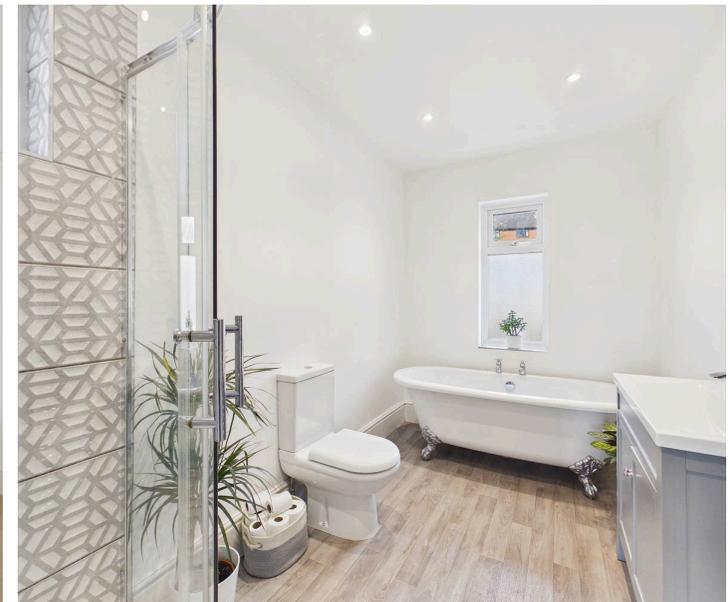

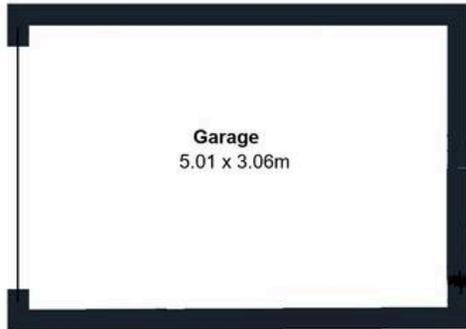

**CREDITON** is a vibrant market town with a bustling high street full of independent shops, eateries, and pubs. In recent years a diverse arts scene has grown to include all manner of mediums, with the performing arts making use of the town's market square where, in the summer months, a range of activities take place. The market square is also home to the town's twice-monthly farmer's market. The town has an equally significant past. It was originally the first Bishopric in Devon and the imposing Parish Church of The Holy Cross now stands where once stood Devon's first Saxon cathedral (909-1050AD). It is also the birthplace of Saint Boniface, one of the founding fathers of the Christian church in Europe. Easily commutable to Exeter and with two primary schools, a secondary school with sixth form as well as a wide range of necessary amenities, it's clear why the town is a firm favourite with locals and relocators alike.
