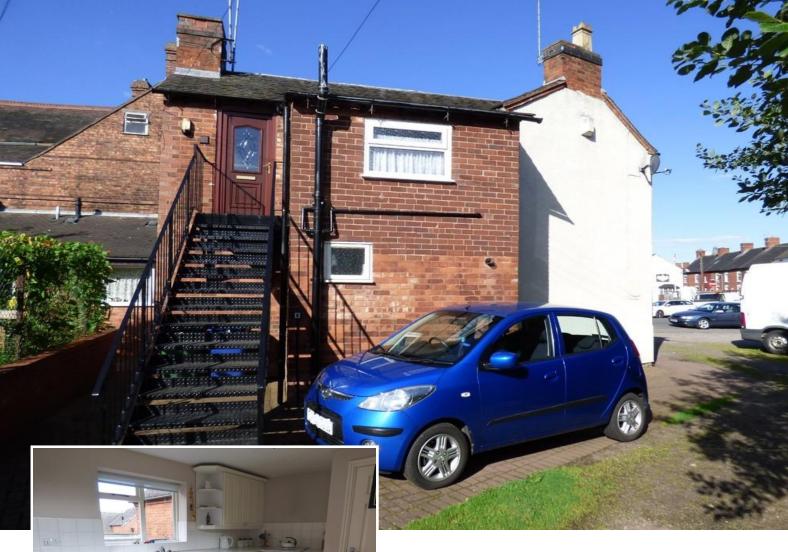

An inner hall leads off the kitchen and has access to the loft and both bathroom and lounge.

A well proportioned lounge faces to the front and enjoys both views of Elmore Lane, Crossley Stone, Bow Street and Elmore Park. Wall mounted gas fire.

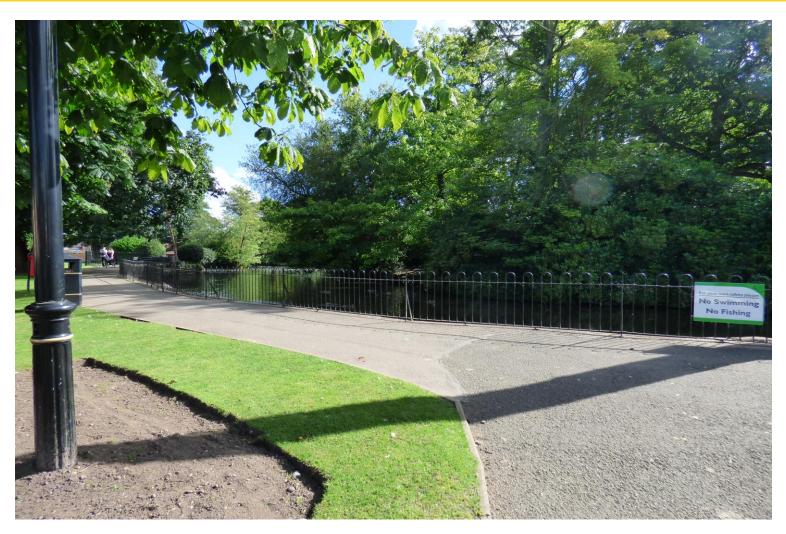










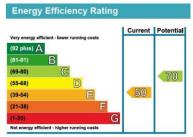
