DESCRIPTION: This modern detached house is situated in this ever-popular part of Crediton, with easy access to the town or link road to Exeter, or in the opposite direction, beautiful rolling hills and many country walks.

The four bedroom accommodation includes an en-suite shower room to the master, built in wardrobes to bedroom2, plus a white suite bathroom with shower over the bath and a heated towel rail.

Downstairs we have the living room with open fire, double doors leading to the dining room/study and the beautiful conservatory, which is currently used as a dining room, with a double radiator allowing year round use. There is also a downstairs WC, mains gas central heating and uPVC double glazing throughout.

The mature gardens are very pretty with areas of lawn interspersed with an array of beautiful beds and borders. There are further areas to the side and rear of the garage (ideal for clothes drying or a private retreat), plus a garden shed. The detached garage has light and numerous power points (partially used as a workshop, with off-road parking in front too.

DIRECTIONS: From the High Street, turn into Market Street and follow the road into Parliament Street. Proceed past the library and continue until arriving at a mini-roundabout. Turn left into Jockey Hill and immediately right into Pounds Hill. Proceed to the top of the hill, around to the right into Beech Park. Number 26 will be found along on your left.
