The property is alongside the B4393 and is approximately 2.5 miles east of the small town of Llanfyllin which has primary and secondary schools, a modern doctors practice including dentist, mini-mart, several pubs and privately owned shops. Welshpool and Oswestry are within reasonable travelling distances.





The chapel was constructed of brick and slate in 1891 (according to the date stone) with the detached stone and slate cottage to the rear being built previously and we understand was a skinning and tannery cottage.



The chapel comprises a single storey building and measures internally $8m \times 6m$.



The chapel house is a two up, two down and measures externally 8.8m x 5m.

Both properties require renovation and modernisation.
