







#### Property Description



Situated directly opposite Buckingham Palace and comprising c.15,845 square feet (1,472 square metres), the beautiful townhouse is arranged over seven floors, offering five reception rooms and six principal bedrooms as well as staff accommodation.

reaching 14'5" (4.4 m).
