moredetail...

This substantial semi- detached Edwardian house is conveniently located in the heart of the vibrant town centre of Seaford, within an easy walk of the main shopping high street, train station and uncommercialised beach front. The property offers versatile accommodation and would suit home/income as a B&B or holiday lets.

To the front of the property there is a terraced garden with raised south facing patio and covered veranda, bordered by established planting providing seclusion. A tiled path leads to the entrance door and vestibule with useful space for coats and boots. The entrance hall has solid wood flooring which continues to the principal rooms and there is a cloakroom/WC

To the front of the property are the main reception rooms which are south facing. The sitting room has an attractive fireplace with open grate and from the drawing room there are double doors to the front veranda/terrace

The separate dining room has a pleasant outlook over the rear courtyard and connecting door to the dual aspect kitchen which has an extensive range of fitted cupboards and ample work surface complemented by a tiled floor. There are all the usual appliances to include double oven with gas hob, dish washer, double fridge/freezer and utility cupboard with washing machine, whilst there is a door to the courtyard.

On the first floor there are three double bedrooms with the master bedroom having the benefit of an en-suite shower/WC and access to the south facing balcony from bedroom two and both rooms have south aspect views towards Seaford Head. Bedroom three is self contained and has an en-suite bathroom/WC.

The second floor has three further double bedrooms, with bedroom six again being self contained with an en-suite bathroom/WC and views from the two front bedrooms.

Outside the rear courtyard garden has an area of lawn with well establish trees and bushes which provide seclusion and there is gated side access.
