Hawkinge

Made up of the old and the new, Hawkinge is fast becoming one of the most popular places to be in the Folkestone area. Having a huge range of home styles from terraced houses all the way up to detached barns and executive homes, Hawkinge has all you need. The area has a great reputation for local schooling and the transport links to the surrounding big cities are fantastic. Approximately 12 miles from the city of Canterbury and 3 miles from the seaside town of Folkestone in the county of Kent.
