Located on St Davids Hill (on the junction to Hele Road), this purpose built development was completed in 1998 by McCarthy & Stone and comprises of 33 1 and 2 bedroom flats. The property has excellent facilities including a lift, recreation room, communal gardens, laundry, recycling area and residents' car parking (first come, first served). Being a modern building, it is efficient, clean and tidy in all areas and is clearly well looked after. There is a duty manager, alarm pulls and secure entry too.

Once into the flat itself, which is larger than average, on the first floor and at the back (away from the road and with a view) the décor is neutral and the kitchen and shower room have been updated to provide clean and modern spaces meaning someone could move straight in. The kitchen has built in appliances including a Neff combi oven, Bosch hob and both under counter fridge and dishwasher too. There are built in wardrobes to the bedroom plus a store cupboard in the hall. The living room has plenty of space for a table too and there is a lovely outlook to the gardens and St Davids church.


