



The Coal Authority has records of over 175,000 mine entries within the UK captured in the National Coal Mining database, derived from sources including abandonment plans, geological and topographical plans.







## Risk Rating: Very low

The map does not contain sufficient information for it to be used to determine flood risk to individual properties, but it does give you an indication of whether your area may be affected by surface water flooding at this risk level.

- **High Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 30 (3.3%) in any one year.
- **Medium Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 100 (1.0%) in any one year.
- **Low Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 1000 (0.1%) in any one year.
- Very Low Risk an area in which the risk is below 1 in 1000 (0.1%) in any one year.






# **Rivers & Seas - Climate Change**

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

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

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






## **Radon Gas**



#### What is Radon?

Radon is a natural radioactive gas, which enters buildings from the ground. Exposure to high concentrations increases the risk of lung cancer. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) recommends that radon levels should be reduced in homes where the annual average is at or above 200 becquerels per cubic metre (200 Bq/m3).
