This charming Grade II Listed cottage offers a wealthy of character and is located in a pretty period terrace of similar properties. The

property has been extended to the rear, has two ground floor reception rooms and rather uniquely for a property within this terrace has three good bedrooms. Outside there is an attractive and good sized courtyard garden which to the rear features a stunning Sussex flint wall. The property is located in the city centre and is within a short distance of the many shops, bars and restaurants that Chichester has to offer.

Accommodation

The light and airy accommodation is arranged over three floors. As you enter on the ground floor there is a charming sitting room, complete with original open fire. Moving further into the property there is a second reception room, complete with original floorboards and used as a dining room and beyond this a galley style fitted kitchen. Located to the rear, a family bathroom completes the ground floor. On the first floor, off a central landing there is a large master bedroom and a further double bedroom. On the second floor lies a cleverly arranged (to maximise space) third bedroom, complete with dormer. Outside to the rear there is a good sized and pretty courtyard garden which is mainly paved and complete with a Sussex flint wall and side access via a 6ft wooden gate. To the front there is a shingled area enclosed by a low level wall with a paved path leading to the front door.

Location

The property is located in Chichester's dynamic and vibrant centre. The city's historic centre offers an enviable selection of bars, restaurants and shops. Chichester is renowned for the highly regarded Festival Theatre, Pallant House Gallery and its close proximity to The Goodwood Estate, famous for both motor car and horse racing. To the south of the city is Chichester Harbour (designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty), and within lies the blue flag beach of West Wittering. Chichester station provides rail links to London via the Victoria Line but also via Havant and the Waterloo Line, the station also links connections right along the south coast.


